7. Form of consideration

Administrative decision.

8. Deadline for consideration

Without unnecessary delay, no later than within one month from the day of the commencement of the proceedings, and in a particularly complex case, no later than within two months from the date of initiation of the proceedings. Information on the status of the case can be obtained at the phone numbers indicated in the "Handled by" section.

9. Documents obtained in the proceedings

- 1) Documents referred to in section 5 point 3 of the procedure in the event of a failure to submit them with the application;
- 2) An applicant's declaration that he/she undertakes to comply with the regulations in force at the place where the shelter was provided;
- 3) If necessary, other documents confirming the person's situation.

10. Appeal procedure

The decision can be referred to the Local Government Appeal Court in Krakow for appeal through the authority that issued it within 14 days from the date of receipt of the decision. Appeals should be submitted to the Municipal Social Welfare Centre in Krakow - the branch appropriate for the place of residence or the Homeless Support Department in the case of homeless people. Appeals are not subject to fees.

- 2) If the income of a person or a person in a family does not exceed the income criterion referred to in art. 8 par. 1 point 1 of the Act on social aid, aid in the form of a shelter is provided free of charge. In other cases, the amount of payment is determined in accordance with resolution No. LIII/722/12 of the Krakow City Council of 29 August 2012 on the organization and detailed rules for paying fees for stays in support centres and night shelters. Pursuant to the Act on social aid, the income criterion of a single person is 634 PLN, and the family members 514 PLN.
