AD.1 Opening the meeting of the Interdisciplinary Team to Collaborate in the Implementation of the "Open Krakow" Program.

Adam Bulandra - Deputy Chairman of the Team welcomed everyone present at the Vth meeting of the Interdisciplinary Team in 2019, then put the agenda to the vote. The agenda was adopted with the order of points changed, i.e. point 2.4) was presented in the first place due to the presence of Mrs. Agnieszka Biernat. The order of the meeting with this change was adopted by acclamation.

acceptance by the Team Members of the proposal for the form of distinction and the course of the gala.

Agnieszka Biernat - Mr. Adam Bulandra welcomed the manager, Agnieszka Biernat, and gave her the floor to discuss the proposal for the form of distinction prepared by the SZ-04 unit

and organization of the KAW gala. The information was presented in the form of a presentation in which the following issues were raised:

- graphic mark, this year's edition is communicated in the form of the multicolored Lajkonik. A manual will be created from next year's edition before the competition,
- catering - various cuisines of the world,
- announcers,
- artistic setting,
- awards,
- events with nominees.

After the presentation, Members made comments regarding:

- simultaneous translation into English and Ukrainian;
- graphic mark - permanent element, in the next editions of the competition a manual will be prepared for the assumed graphic mark;
- awards - it was proposed for the selection of the award to be preceded by a competition for form and performance.

After the discussion, it was established that additional proposals from Team Members can be sent to open.krakow@um.krakow.pl within 7 days.

Discussing the proposal to create a position of a **spokesperson for Ukrainians** in the structure of the City of Krakow.

Adam Bulandra - the host asked Mr. Dmitry Bajew to take the floor.

Dmitry Bajew - he said a few words about himself and about his stay in Poland since 1996. He runs the Polish-Ukrainian Foundation, which supports Ukrainians in "acclimatization" in Poland. He drew attention to the need to improve communication between Krakow's residents, indigenous and foreign, educational support, and Ukrainian entrepreneurs. The role of the spokesperson for Ukrainians is proposed to be a social function, it would be a bridge between the city structures and the society of Ukrainian origin that wants to settle in Krakow. He gave an example of appointing a plenipotentiary and a spokesperson for Ukrainians in Wrocław - Mr. Olga.

Members of the Team commented on the issue and discussed the motives for distinguishing Ukrainians as one of the groups of foreigners present in Krakow. They wondered about the tasks that the spokesperson would perform. Team members believe that the task of the Information Point for Foreigners, and the Multicultural Center in the future, is to help the people who have come to Krakow in their needs. What is more, the team should also take into account the needs of other groups of foreigners, minority groups, etc., even if they are not numerous. Attention was paid to the specificity of Ukrainians due to the size of this group in Krakow, the largest of all others. Members of the Team, after many proposals to resolve the issue of aid aimed at Ukrainians, proposed the invitation of the spokesperson for Ukrainians from Wrocław

to the meeting of the Team, in order to get acquainted with the details of this position, rules of cooperation, etc.

AD.2 Issue concerning the implementation of the "Open Kraków" Program - Discussion of the task:

3) Team Recommendations - discussion of the formula and recipient.

Piotr Kwapisiewicz – suggested that the team, as a consultative body, recommended broad and general activities of non-governmental organizations, especially in the field of research for the benefit of society. In his opinion, the project budget does not matter to the social effects of the project. The team should not recommend all projects that ask for an opinion because they do not have enough resources.

Jakub Kościółek – drew attention to the goal of presenting the tasks carried out by non-governmental organizations at the Meeting of the Team, which is to inform about what is happening in Krakow, especially in the field of education and why it should serve.

Adam Bulandra clarified the purpose of recommendations for the project which, in his opinion, is to mobilize the city to facilitate the implementation of projects that, due to non-standard activities, encounter resistance and fear of directors running schools or other institutions. The goal of the recommendation is to break the barrier.

Tomasz Dąbrowski – suggested recommendations in working teams.

Urszula Majcher – Legawiec – also drew attention to the fears that accompany decision-makers not to expose the subject to possible negative consequences using research for purposes inconsistent with their original idea.
