After almost 5 years of implementation, the EU-funded project <u>ADMin4ALL - Supporting</u> social inclusion of vulnerable migrants in Europe comes to an end. With 33 localities in 7 EU member States engaged and over 1,000 local social service providers trained, **ADMin4ALL** is today a EU-wide community of cities committed to integration.

The final event will take stock of the work done to support local authorities across Europe in fostering the social inclusion of migrants. It will also offer an opportunity to look into the latest developments of EU migration and integration policy. Moreover, **representatives from different EU cities** will discuss the challenges faced and the **good practices put in place to foster social cohesion**, including in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic.
